Corporate worship in the Scriptures is...

1. Focused on \_\_\_\_\_:
  - a. We honor the Lord as worthy. *Revelation 4:11; 5:9-10, 12*
  - b. God is the \_\_\_\_\_; we are \_\_\_\_\_.
2. Both \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. We \_\_\_\_\_ external things to honor God.
    - In the Old Testament...
      - The Hebrew words mean...
        - Serve.
        - Adore (express love, admiration and devotion).
        - Prostrate oneself.
      - Worship included sacrifices, music and noise. *Psalm 150:3-5; 47:1*
    - In the New Testament...
      - The New Testament words mean...
        - Bend the knee: show adoration, respect and humility by kneeling.
        - From a committed heart offer sacrifice or service without thought of reward.
        - Conduct a public service on behalf of the whole group.
      - Worship services...
        - Included teaching. *2 Timothy 4:13*

- Were to be orderly and strengthening. *1 Corinthians 14:40, 26*
- Were understandable to outsiders. *1 Corinthians 14:23-24*

b. Internally, we \_\_\_\_\_ with God.

- Sincerely meet with God. *Hebrews 10:22*
- \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves with His ways. *Psalm 51:17; Isaiah 1:11-17*

If the \_\_\_\_\_ is in rebellion,

3. Worship honors God and \_\_\_\_\_ us.
